5/28/20 Healthcare 3 - three residents were tested in the last 24 hours due to one resident presenting with cold signs and symptoms. Two additional residents were tested due to exposure to the resident with cold symptoms. Testing is being completed as a preventative measure to provide for timely identification and intervention if needed. Healthcare 1 and Healthcare 2 continue to show improvement in all residents with no new symptoms noted. Healthcare 1 was moved to "Unaffected unit" designation of COVID-19. To designate a unit as unaffected the facility must meet the following criteria: All residents on the unit who were confirmed or probable cases of COVID-19 must have met the criteria for discontinuation of transmission-based precautions. A minimum of 14 days have passed since the date of symptom onset for the last clinical case. A minimum of 14 days have passed since the implementation of transmission-based precautions for COVID-19 and other infection prevention and control interventions for COVID-19. All residents who were not confirmed or probable cases of COVID-19 remain asymptomatic. All staff remain asymptomatic or have met return-to-work criteria as defined by PA State Law and no additional or ongoing exposures have occurred.
