6/3/20 Since last reported two staff members in the nursing facility were tested and positive for COVID-19. The facility completed a review of all residents and contact tracing. Two residents were noted with symptoms of COVID-19. Both residents were tested for COVID-19 as well as the residents roommate to rule out exposure. Resident representatives were contacted and updated on the resident status and plan of care. The facility is monitoring all residents at risk and have quarantined exposed residents for the next 14 days. 6/3/20 Through the partnership with the PA Department of Health COVID-19 support team the facility will be testing all residents and staff this Friday as part of Point Prevalence Testing. This testing will identify any potential cases of COVID-19 in individuals that are currently asymptomatic. This testing is very beneficial to identify additional risks related to COVID-19 in the facility environment so that the facility leadership can plan for and manage residents in a manner that prevents the spread of COVID-19 during the period of time that an individual is infected with the virus but is asymptomatic. In the interim period the facility is following all state and federal guidance related to COVID-19 prevention, identification and risk mitigation.
