The separation of this number from the in-house acquired COVID-19 cases is important when establishing resolution of COVID-19 for existing cases as well as the effectiveness of current facility practices. Due to the facilities previous exposure to COVID-19, management of COVID-19 cases acquired outside of the facility do not present as a risk to the facility residents or staff. The policies and procedures implemented at the facility manage resident needs and risks according to state and federal guidance while providing placement to residents who require skilled nursing support.
