05/28/20 Towne Centre Healthcare 1 was designated as an "Unaffected COVID-19" Unit.

05/31/20 Towne Centre Healthcare 2 was designated as an "Unaffected COVID-19" Unit.

6/3/20 StoneRidge Towne Centre through the partnership with the PA Department of Health will be completed point prevalence testing with all staff and residents at the facility who were not previously tested as positive. This testing is very beneficial to identify additional risks related to COVID-19 in the facility environment so that the facility leadership can plan for and manage residents in a manner that prevents the spread of COVID-19 during the period of time that an individual is infected with the virus but is asymptomatic. This testing is anticipated to be completed this week.

6/5/20 Update - StoneRidge Towne Centre spoke with the PA Department of Health COVID-19 Support Team today. The testing kits for residents and staff at Towne Centre are being shipped from the Bureau of Laboratories today and the facility is anticipating their arrival on Tuesday. Upon arrival the team at Towne Centre will begin testing for all staff and residents who were not previously identified as positive for COVID-19 in the past. This testing will assist the facility in planning for care and isolating concerns to prevent further spread of COVID-19. At present time there are no identified residents presenting with symptoms of COVID-19 at the facility.

6/6/20 StoneRidge Towne Centre has noted the onset of residents with respiratory symptoms in the personal care facility. At present two residents were tested, one test result was negative and the other is pending. The resident with the pending test was moved to the skilled facility Healthcare 3 and quarantined due to clinical symptoms requiring additional nursing support. All other residents in personal care are asymptomatic. The facility has contacted all resident representatives for any resident affected and will continue to update individuals with any changing activity.

6/6/20 StoneRidge Towne Centre has three staff with pending test results are currently not working until test results are received by the facility and the staff member meets the criteria to return to work. StoneRidge continues to work with State agencies and is following all State and Federal Guidance related to the prevention, identification and management of COVID-19 for both staff and residents.

6/6/20 StoneRidge Towne Centre submitted a formal request for State support with COVID-19 testing for residents and staff at the Towne Centre personal care facility this past Friday. Additionally, the corporation is working with an external agency to support mass testing (point prevalence survey) in the event the State is not able to assist. The facility plans to begin testing all residents and staff for personal care mid to late this week regardless of State support. Facility staff will be contacting resident representatives early this week to review and obtain verbal consent for testing.
