6/9/20 Initial testing was completed at Poplar Run - testing noted that 19 residents and 2 staff members were identified as being positive for COVID-19 at Poplar Run. Four residents were transferred to Towne Centre Healthcare 3 COVID-19 cohort to allow for the management of the additional 15 COVID-19 residents on one hallway at Poplar Run. The 15 residents who tested positive were all moved to the cohort COVID-19 area on A Hall and the exposed residents who previously resided on A Hall and tested negative were transferred to open beds/rooms on B, C and D Halls with other COVID negative residents. Residents who tested negative and who were exposed to COVID-19 by other residents and staff who tested positive on B, C and D halls - guidance from State and Federal regulations require residents to be quarantined for 14 days from Friday June 5, 2020. This quarantine period is the time that an individual who has been exposed to COVID-19 has the potential to develop symptoms of the COVID-19 virus converting them from a Negative status to a Positive diagnosis for COVID-19. Due to this fact the facility will be testing all negative staff and residents weekly until no additional positive residents or staff are identified and the facility is designated as an unaffected facility - free of active COVID-19. Facility staff continue to follow all State and Federal guidance related to the prevention and management of COVID-19 to and including visitation restrictions (with the exception of compassionate care), social distancing, covering eyes, nose and mouth at all times for caregivers and cloth masks when caring for residents.

6/9/20 Poplar Run Personal Care - all outstanding COVID-19 swab tests were received at the facility. All residents and staff tests were noted to be negative for COVID-19. At present time the facility is still working through the plans to initiate baseline testing for Personal Care residents. Updates to the website and notification to staff and residents will be completed as the plans are developed and a date for testing is determined. At this time no additional residents have been identified with symptoms of COVID-19 or respiratory conditions.
