Resident room visits are permitted based on the residents preference, clinical status, roommate needs, and facility COVID-19 activity. Residents visitation accommodations are determined on an individual basis based on the resident and interdisciplinary team review and discussion.

We will continue to do outbreak testing as recommended by the CDC and DOH on the entire HCC1 floor. 4/24/2023 One resident tested positive on Healthcare 1. The rest of the residents mentioned in the contact tracing tested negative. Testing will repeat on Wednesday 4/26/2023, Thursday 4/27/2023, Monday 5/1/2023, 5/4/2023, and 5/8/2023.

There was exposure on HCC1, all staff are wearing N-95s and the residents are being tested according to DOH and CDC protocol. The COVID positive employee was taken off of the schedule until her quarantine period is up following the return to work guidance. Testing will continue per state and federal guidance until the facility has a period of 14 days with no new cases. The positive staff member is currently not working and quarantining at home. Staff receive ongoing education on infection control precautions, handwashing and use of personal protective equipment application and removal. Residents in red or yellow zone designation staff wear N95 masks, face shield, gloves for care and isolation gown per CDC guidance.</p>
