



## **Independent Living Reopening Plan Family Visitation Guidance**

- StoneRidge Retirement Living has identified 3 separate neutral zones for family visitation:
  - Outdoor patio/pond area - 5 tables
  - Outdoor Meier Room patio area - 4 tables
  - Inside Theatre - 4 tables
    - We ask that residents and visitors do not move furniture in the visiting areas as areas are setup to comply with State and Federal Guidance and social distancing.
- All independent living visitors must enter the facility by the main entrance, the single point entrance to access the facility. All visitors must pass the screening process and be free of a temperature to proceed with visitation.
- Families must follow all State and Federal guidance for out of household visitation such as wearing a mask at all times and social distancing which includes no physical contact such as hugging.
- Residents will meet visitors at the designated neutral zone for their scheduled visitation.
- Visitation time slots are outlined in 30 minute increments, with a 30-minute post visit period to allow for staff to prepare the area for the next visitation which includes disinfecting the visitation area. i.e. 10:00 am – 10:30 am, next visit 11:00 am- 11:30 am
- Visitation will not be scheduled over the lunch hour, with the last scheduled visitation from 4:00 to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday.
- At present, visitation will only be scheduled Monday through Friday from 9:30 AM to 11:30 AM and 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM to allow for adequate staff resources to assist and disinfect visitation areas.
- All visitations areas will be monitored during scheduled visitations to insure compliance with visitation policies.
- We request that visitors respect the reopening visitation plan and adhere to the provisions outlined for everyone's safety.
- Upon completion of a scheduled visitation we ask that visitors exit the premises and not proceed to an independent living resident's apartment for continued visitation as the visitation policy is in place to allow for a safe transition to the communities reopening process. Unnecessary risks could create

delays in the reopening plan and increased restrictions on visitation due to the unpredictable nature of COVID-19 and the manner in which it is spread.

- If you start with a temperature or any symptom indicative of COVID-19 or are diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of your visit to the community, please contact the communities Independent Living Director at 717-866-3204.
