Contact tracing was completed with one resident and one staff member being identified. Both the resident and staff member were tested, and negative for COVID with a pending lab PCR swab. The resident identified has previously been vaccinated and is considered fully covered. This resident will not need to quarantine and is currently being monitored for any respiratory symptoms or temperature. The staff member has not been vaccinated and is currently quarantining for their 14 day required period. The facility will continue with weekly staff testing based on the recent case and county positivity rates. All staff follow state and federal guidance related to infection control protocols and the use of PPE.
